Day 1

10:00 a.m. **Arrive** in Greenwood and tour **Greenwood's MS Blues Trail Markers** – Greenwood has a special relationship with the blues – a music born of field hollers used in the days when cotton was picked by hand. Currently, there are eight MS Blues Trail markers in Leflore County. They commemorate **Robert Johnson's gravesite, B.B. King's birthplace, Hubert Sumlin, Elks Hart Lodge No. 640, Baptist Town, Guitar Slim, Furry Lewis and WGRM Radio Station.** A complete map can be found at www.msbluestrail.org

12:00 p.m. **Lunch at the Crystal Grill** (est. 1933) The Crystal Grill is a Greenwood institution that has been in operation for a century.
