Culinary Community

If you leave Greenwood hungry, you have only yourself to blame. *Fan & Johnny's* chef snagged a James Beard Award nomination, and the Ballas family has been rolling comfort food and world-famous pies out of the *Crystal Grill's* kitchen for three-quarters of a century. *Giardina's* and *Lusco's* feature upscale evening dining choices that range from pompano to porterhouse. Expect the unexpected at *Fan & Johnny's*, a fresh culinary experience for the Delta with unique specials updated daily. *Turnrow Books'* upstairs cafe is the place to go for lunchtime soups, salads and sandwiches, and *Webster's* is a cozy spot just across the Keesler Bridge in North Greenwood. Other culinary temptations range from *Serio's* open-face meatball sandwich to *Veronica's* intricate cakes and treats to *Steven's* barbecue and famous chocolate cake. If your tastes run to local wines, check out *The Winery at Williams Landing*, located in Greenwood's restored Fire Station #1 at the south end of Howard Street. Besides the expected muscadine, they also feature interesting fig (Delta Dew) and blueberry (Delta Blue) wines. And if you're inspired to try your own hand at kitchen magic, sign up for one of the *Viking Cooking School's* classes, where you can become the master of your grill or the pastry chef of your neighborhood!

Breakfast Options

If you're a guest at the Alluvian, you'll find a full Southern breakfast buffet laid out in the 4th floor Terrace Room each morning. *Steven's BBQ* opens before daybreak with full Southern breakfast every weekday. If brunch is more of your speed, *Station 222* and *Serio's* has you covered! Or try a latte and a homemade pastry at our local coffee shop, *Mississippi Moe Joe Coffee Company*.

Lunch Options

Turnrow Books features an upstairs cafe with daily soup specials, creative salads and a variety of sandwiches that are more than a meal. They'll also fix you a latte or espresso to enjoy on their screened porch. *Steven's BBQ* lays out barbecue, briskets, a vegetable buffet and the best chocolate cake in the Delta each day at lunch. *Fan & Johnny's* sports a menu of unique appetizers and daily surprises from the creative kitchen of James Beard Award nominee Taylor Ricketts. The *Crystal Grill* has been overwhelming their patrons with a mile-long menu for the past seventy years. Whether you're hungry for a vegetable plate that spills over the side, onion rings that melt in your mouth or a chef salad that doesn't even pretend to be healthy, you'll have to save room for the sky-high pies behind the counter. Or try *San Miguel Arcangel Taqueria* and experience their culinary gem pico de gallo.

Dinner Options

When the sun goes down, Greenwood gets serious about nobody going to bed hungry. Lusco's has been opening its doors on Carrollton Avenue since Prohibition, which explains the curtained rooms and the air of "anything goes." Famed for its pompano and steaks, Lusco's invites you to bring your own bottle and settle in for a meal that might go on from sundown to the wee hours of the morning. Giardina's, connected to the Alluvian lobby by its popular bar, carries a legendary Delta culinary name into the new century. As with Lusco's, you'll probably have your own private room with exceptional white-linen service and cosmopolitan creations. Start off with their famous onion rings with comeback and move on to world-class steaks, seafood or pasta. Serio's honors the family's classic Italian culinary traditions from the original Serio's of the 1940's, while weaving a contemporary twist into the cuisine, including a variety of fish, steak and healthy eating options. Play a little bocce ball while you're there. Webster's is tucked into a historic home just across Yazoo River in North Greenwood. Pick up a drink at their well-stocked bar and settle in for a relaxed hamburger, po-boy, salad or specialty item. The atmosphere is casual and you'll often find the young folks of Greenwood gathered here for a lively round of trivia or football watching. Mai Little China offers elegant entrees as well as their homemade eggrolls. The recipe has been in the family for over 100 years!
